## **RN-BSN CURRICULUM PLAN**

### In order to be eligible for the RN-BSN program the applicant must:

- 1. Be enrolled in an accredited associate degree program
- 2. Show proof of a valid non-restricted RN license (if student is a new graduate the RN license must be received no later than the fourth week of the beginning semester)
- 3. Have an overall GPA of 2.75 or higher on all college-level course work
- 4. Have applied and been accepted to LMU (waived for current LMU ASN students)
- 5. Apply for admission to the Caylor School of Nursing (waived for current LMU ASN students)

# If the applicant to the RN-BSN option is a graduate of the LMU ASN Program, the following general education requirements have been met: (Graduates from other ASN programs may have also completed all or most of these general education requirements.)

*Note:* Students who hold a current registered nurse license making application to the RN-BSN Program could receive up to 31 upper – level credit hours for proficiency validated by licensure. In order to receive credit hours for knowledge validated by licensure the registered nurse must:

- Hold a current unrestricted registered nurse license in the state in which the student resides.
- *Have been active in clinical practice for one year, or have graduated from a nursing program within the last year*
- *Have earned a grade of "C" or better in previous nursing courses.*
- Completed 16 credit hours in the RN-BSN Program in the Caylor School of Nursing
