Important Points Regarding the Use of Masks:

- Surgical masks are being distributed across campus and to the extended sites.
- These masks should be placed in high traffic areas, such as outside classrooms or at building entrances.
- If someone is coughing or sneezing, that person should wear a mask to limit the spread of germs. Encourage anyone you see who may be coughing or sneezing to use a mask. This is as much for the health of the sick person as it is for the health of the rest of the campus community.
- Due to the high demand for masks nationwide, there is currently a shortage of supply. We have a limited number of masks available. Encourage sick individuals to use the masks as often as needed. At the same time, discourage waste on the part of those who may not have legitimate reason to wear a mask.
- If you must come into close contact with someone that may be sick, both of you should wear a mask. Anyone transporting a sick individual to the doctor should wear a mask during the transport.
