



Judy has been on the road since the early 1990s, making the songs and ballads of traditional Americana and the British Isles her own. She has family roots in Virginia, and was lucky enough to be born into a music-loving family. This led to her discovery of the rich and varied treasure of folk music and inspired her recordings. Judy has four full length CDs. Her first CD of unaccompanied traditional songs and ballads, “*If You Sing Songs...*” was released in 1998, followed two years later by “*Far From the Lowlands.*” “*Tenting Tonight: Songs of the Civil War*” was released in 2007, and “*Lincoln's America*” in 2009. Respected on both sides of the Atlantic as both a singer and interpreter of traditional songs, Judy’s varied repertoire has resulted in an array of entertaining and informative themed (and enthusiastically received) programs.
