SCHOLARSHIP FUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

Southwest Virginia's Lincoln Memorial University Alumni Association has established a scholarship trust fund to reflect one measure of their support to Lincoln Memorial University and its student body. The scholarship program is to be administered by the Association's Scholarship Trust Fund Committee. This scholarship will be available to students graduating from a high school located in Lee County. The applicant should be enrolled or in the process of enrolling as a student at Lincoln Memorial University with the intent of pursuing a four-year scholastic program leading to a bachelor's degree.

The scholarship is to be given yearly in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) with payment to be released to the student after a letter is received from the LMU Admissions Office stating that the student is enrolled at Lincoln Memorial University. The Committee may decide not to give a scholarship in any particular year or may decide to give one or two scholarships, depending upon the availability of funds. Only one grant will be given to an individual student per year. A grant is to be given for one year but may be renewed in a following year after resubmission of an application.

Students wishing to apply may do so through the school guidance office. They should meet the following criteria:

1. Have not less than a "C" average scholastic ability.
2. Have a need for funding assistance.
3. Have a written recommendation from school authorities.
4. Have submitted a completed application, along with a transcript of grades.
5. Have submitted an essay (not more than one typed page) as to why they need the money and their future plans and aspirations.

Application forms may be picked up at the high school guidance office or LMU. Applications, grade transcripts, and a short essay are to be submitted to the Scholarship Trust Fund Committee Chairman, Mr. Jim Whitt, by May 1, preceding the school year for which the grant is needed.

Write a brief essay about your needs, goals, expectations, and ambitions in regard to your future education. (Not more than one typed page.)
