Note 1: Students entering the teacher licensure program must have a minimum gpa of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Candidates must submit an ACT composite score of 22, an SAT Combined score of 1020 , or PRAXIS I (PPST) with Reading of 174, Writing of 173 and Math of 173 prior to admission to the teacher licensure program. Students need to submit their test scores to the LMU education department the semester prior to their enrollment at LMU. If needed, students can retake the admissions test during their first semester of enrollment at LMU.

Note 2: The total number of hours in Math and Science taken at SKCTC must total a minimum of eighteen hours. Students must also choose a course that meets SKCTC's cultural studies requirement.
