Students who hold a current registered nurse license making application to the RN-BSN Option will receive 31 upper-level nursing credit hours for proficiency validated by licensure. In order to receive credit hours for knowledge validated by licensure the registered nurse must: 1. Hold a current unrestricted registered nurse license in the state of Tennessee, or be licensed in a compact state, 2. Have been active in clinical practice for the last two years, or have graduated from a nursing program within the last year, 3. Have earned a grade of "C" in previous nursing courses, and 4.
