This program leads to an Associate of Science in Elementary Education from Walters State Community College and a Bachelor of Science in Liberal Studies and Human Development from Lincoln Memorial University. The following is a **suggested** four year program of study. The courses highlighted in gray are not required by WSCC, but are required in LMU's teacher licensure program. These courses may be completed at either institution.

Note: Students entering the teacher licensure program must have a minimum cumulative gpa of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Candidates must submit an enhanced ACT composite score of 22, an SAT combined Critical Reading and Math score of 1020 or PRAXIS I (PPST) with Reading of 174, Writing of 173 and Math of 173 prior to admission to the teacher education program. These are the minimum scores and gpa set by the state for admission to teacher licensure. Students need to submit the test scores to the education department the semester prior to enrolling at LMU. If needed, students can retake the admission test during their first semester of enrollment at LMU.

⁴Literature- choose from ENGL 2110, 2120, 2410 or 2420.

⁵SPED 2010 will substitute for LMU's EDUC 300 and with the approval of the department chair EDUC 2300 will substitute for LMU's EDUC 290.

⁶Major Core- choose from English, Science, Mathematics or Social Science (ECON, GEOG, HIST or POLI).
