Pre-Medical Technology (AS) to Medical Technology (BS)

This program leads to an Associate of Science degree in Pre-Medical Technology from Walters State Community College and a Bachelor of Science in Medical Technology from Lincoln Memorial University. The following is a **suggested** four year program of study. Lincoln Memorial University requires a minimum of 128 semester hours for a baccalaureate degree; a minimum of 60 semester hours must be completed at a senior level institution.
