Students in the **part-time program** will be enrolled in multiple sections of all classes. The Office of Academic Affairs will register you for your classes and sections. Sections B & C of the three skills classes (Legal Foundations I, Legal Communication I, and Legal Research I) will be enrolled in Section A of the two doctrinal classes (Civil Procedure I and Torts II). Section D of the skills classes will be enrolled in Section B of the doctrinal classes. Section A of the skills classes will be split between the doctrinal sections. Part-time students will not be enrolled in Section E of the skills classes.
