

RN-BSN CURRICULUM PLAN

In order to be eligible for the RN-BSN program the applicant must:

1. Be enrolled in an accredited associate degree program
2. Show proof of a valid non-restricted RN license (if student is a new graduate the RN license must be received no later than the fourth week of the beginning semester)
3. Have an overall GPA of 2.75 or higher on all college-level course work
4. Have applied and been accepted to LMU (waived for current LMU ASN students)
5. Apply for admission to the Caylor School of Nursing (waived for current LMU ASN students)

If the applicant to the RN-BSN option is a graduate of the LMU ASN Program, the following general education requirements have been met: (Graduates from other ASN programs may have also completed all or most of these general education requirements.)

Note: Students who hold a current registered nurse license making application to the RN-BSN Program will receive 31 upper – level nursing credit hours for proficiency validated by licensure. In order to receive credit hours for knowledge validated by licensure the registered nurse must:

- Hold a current unrestricted registered nurse license in the State of TN, **or** be licensed in a compact state.
- Have been active in clinical practice for one year, **or** have graduated from a nursing program within the last year
- Have earned a grade of “C” **or** better in previous nursing courses.
- Completed 16 credit hours in the RN-BSN Program in the Caylor School of Nursing
