## **Accelerated Bachelor of Science (ABSN) - General Information**

All applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 to be considered for admission and an earned bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.

Students enrolled in the Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing (ABSN) option will complete a total of 122 credit hours prior to graduation. The program consists of 75 general education credit hours (57 which will have been earned through previous bachelor's degree and 18 hours of required general education courses specific to nursing) and 47 nursing credit hours. The student will complete the program in three terms: Term I (Summer), Term II (Fall), and Term III (Spring). General education course requirements specific to nursing are listed in Table A and Nursing course requirements are listed in Table B.
