

Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) Full-Time Curriculum Plan

The following is a suggested two-year plan of study for freshmen entering the CSON ASN program as full-time status. Students may enter the ASN program after completing some or all the General Education requirements. This plan should be used in conjunction with the University catalog and in consultation with the nursing advisor. Transfer students should contact a nursing advisor if they have questions regarding transfer credit. General Education courses listed on the two-year plan may be taken during other semesters, unless otherwise noted. General Education courses transferred in must be from an accredited institution and must carry a grade of "C" or better. NOTE: In order to graduate in two years (four regular semesters), the student must average successful completion of 13-16 credit hours per semester. **LMU also requires all first-time freshmen students with less than 15 credits of college credit to complete UACT 100 (1 cr hr).**
