




### Adding SL&L activities to a Canvas course


The following instructions will allow you to insert a link in your Canvas course that takes students and faculty to a specific activity in Student Learning & Licensure (SL&L).

**! Important:** Please note that the activity must be created in SL&L first, before it can be linked to Canvas.

1. Navigate to your Course Home Page.
2. Select “Modules” from the Home Page or the Course Navigation Menu.




3. Locate the blank, LMU Assignment Template in the Module where you'd like to place your Watermark activity.




4. Select “Edit” and fill in all of the required elements of the LMU Template including: a Title, Point Value, Assignment Overview, and Guidelines.




6. While still in Edit Mode, locate the Submission Type section of the Assignment Settings. Select “External Tool” from the dropdown menu.




7. Select “Find” next to the text field that appears.



8. Find the Watermark app, select it, and then choose “Select.”




9. Check the box for Load This Tool In A New Tab.

10. Select "Save and Publish" at the bottom of the page.
