

# POLICY NUMBER: DCOM 400.5 (COCA 9.9) PHYSICAL HEALTH SERVICES

#### I. PURPOSE

To establish policies and procedures regarding the provision of access to physical health services to enrolled students receiving education at LMU-DCOM and affiliated sites.

#### II. POLICY STATEMENT

In accordance with the Commission on Osteopathic College Accreditation (COCA) Element 9.9, it is the policy of LMU-DCOM to provide students with access to diagnostic, preventative, and therapeutic health services 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, that is accessible in all locations where LMU-DCOM students receive education.

# VII. STANDARDS

### COCA Standard 9, Element 9:

#### VIII. PROCEDURE

LMU-DCOM students have access to diagnostic, preventive, and therapeutic health services, accessible in all locations where students receive education from LMU-DCOM. All students are required to have health insurance prior to matriculation through graduation and are responsible for costs associated with services rendered.

Students who seek medical attention, including emergency medical attention may do so with any facility of their choosing based on their needs and health insurance coverage.
