

Honors Point System Policy

(Adopted September 19, 2017)

LMU Honors Scholars shall be required to participate in an Honors Program Point System. This system is designed to encourage active participation in the Honors community, the LMU community, and the local, national, and international communities to which we belong. Each Honors Scholar is expected to earn at least 10 points each semester by participating in activities and events in the areas of Academics, Culture, and Service. The specific activities for which points may be earned and their point values are indicated on an official Honors Point System Form. It shall be the responsibility of each Honors Scholar to track and record each semester the points he/she earns on the Honors Point System Form and have the form certified by his/her academic advisor and the Honors Program Director. The Honors Program Director shall keep certified Point System Forms on file.

Honors Scholars who fail to earn at least 10 points in a given semester shall be placed on probation and expected to make up the point deficiency in the next semester. If an Honors Scholar fails to earn the required number of points for two consecutive semesters (including failure to make up a previous semester's point deficiency), that Honors Scholar will be dismissed from the program. Any Honors Scholar who fails to obtain the required number of points in his/her last semester will not graduate with honors. An Honors Scholar who is dismissed from the program (or fails to obtain the required number of points in his/her last semester) may appeal his/her dismissal to the Honors Council.
