Transfer students should contact their advisor if they have questions regarding transfer credit. Courses listed on the four-year plan may be taken during other semesters, based on availability and course placement. This plan meets LMU's general education (Liberal Arts Common Core) requirements, major requirements and 300/400 level course requirements.
NOTE: In order to graduate in four years (eight regular semesters), the student must average successful completion of 16 to 17 credit hours per semester. LMU also requires all first-time freshmen students with less than $\mathbf{1 5}$ credits of college credit to complete UACT 100.
