

**Four-year Plan  
Pre-Law BBA (3+3)**

The following is a suggested four-year plan of study for freshmen entering LMU during the 2026-2027 academic year. This plan should be used in conjunction with the University catalog and in consultation with a professional advisor. Transfer students should contact their advisor if they have questions regarding transfer credit. Courses listed on the four-year plan may be taken during other semesters, based on availability and course placement. This plan meets LMU's general education (Liberal Arts Common Core) requirements, major requirements and 300/400 level course requirements. To participate in the BBA to JD combined degree completion pathway, students must complete the application for the BBA to JD pathway. Once accepted into the pathway, students must meet or exceed the median LSAT score and undergraduate GPA of the previous year's entering law class and complete all required application materials and documentation for admission to the LMU Duncan School of Law. **NOTE: In order to graduate in four years (eight regular semesters), the student must average successful completion of 15 to 16 credit hours per semester. Please refer to the legend at the bottom of the page for an explanation of superscripts. LMU also requires all first-time freshmen students with less than 15 credits of college credit to complete UACT 100.**
