The following presents a typical strategy for completing the requirements within Lincoln Memorial University's (LMU's) **36-Hour Doctoral Program of Study**² which is designed for students entering the program with an Educational Specialist (EdS) degree from **Lincoln Memorial University** in the concentration of Instructional Practices. This plan should be used in conjunction with *LMU's Graduate Catalog* and with advice from the LMU EdD Program Director. As the EdS hours that are being accepted for transfer will have been taken in a given concentration (CI or IP), doctoral degree work must be in this same area of study. This plan reflects the required core, research, and primary concentration coursework. Any student interested in two concentrations or changing their EdS concentration should select the 48-hour program.
