Special Education Add-On Licensure

For those teachers who already hold a Tennessee teaching license, an add-on licensure option is available. With the add-on endorsement, candidates may apply for a provisional teaching license in SPED which permits them to be the teacher of record and employed by a school district at the same time they are enrolled in graduate-level courses. Add-on licensure programs include 12-15 credit hours of graduate coursework. NOTE: Programs of study may change at any time in response to requirements of the TDOE and LMU's departmental changes.
