Lincoln Memorial University requires the following students, enrolled in six or more hours, to carry personal health insurance: Undergraduate, Graduate, and Professional Nursing, Physician Assistants, Doctor of Anatomical Education. Doctor of Medical Science, Master of Science, Veterinary Medicine, Jurisprudence, Dental Medicine, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Osteopathic Medicine. **Your student account will be charged for this insurance coverage**. If you are currently covered by comparable health insurance through the end of the academic year, you may be able to waive **automatic enrollment** in the plan.

The Lincoln Memorial University student injury and sickness insurance plan will be administered by UnitedHealthcare Student Resources for the 2022-2023 academic year. Here are some ways you can better understand your benefits, find care options, manage costs and get more out of your health plan. You are required to take action. If you do not apply for and receive an approved waiver by the close of the waiver period, your student account charge will not be removed.
