(Check this box if you were a dependent or ward of the court at any time since you turned age 13, even if you are no longer a dependent or ward of the court today. For federal student aid purposes, someone who is incarcerated is not considered a ward of the court.)
 Attached are court documents.

I made an error on my FAFSA. I am not and have not been since age 13 an orphan, in foster care, or a dependent or ward of the court.
 You and one parent **MUST** correct the information on your FAFSA at www.studentaid.gov.
